LENSES, BLISTER TRAYS & FOILS 1,2

- Best option: Use a recycling specialist.
- If not accessible: Throw in the waste bin.
- **IMPORTANT:** Never flush your lenses down the toilet or sink!
- Separate the foil lid from the plastic blister. Ensure they are dry before dropping off.

SOLUTION BOTTLES

 Empty bottles can be recycled through municipal household waste management.






LENS CASE

- Check if your eye clinic's specialist recycling box can accept them.
- Purchase a Zero Waste Box which can accept and recycle flexible and rigid plastic products.
- If not accessible: Throw in the waste bin.

MPS LID, STOPPER & TAMPER EVIDENT RINGS 1,2

 These small items cannot currently be recycled and must be thrown in a waste bin.



EXTERNAL 1.2 PACKAGING

 Cardboard packaging can be recycled by municipal household waste management.
