## PARTICIPATE IN A RECYCLING PROGRAM<sup>1,2</sup>

- Specialist recycling companies, such as TerraCycle, offer schemes to recycle contact lens waste at no cost to lens wearers.

## DROP OFF YOUR WASTE<sup>1,2</sup>

- Collect your waste and drop it off in a specialist recycling bin found at participating eye clinics. Find your nearest location by visiting

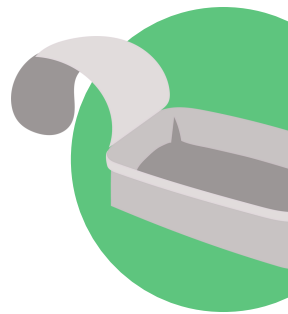


## DAILY DISPOSABLE LENSES<sup>1,2</sup>

- **Best option:** Drop off collected lenses at a specialist recycling bin.
- **If not accessible:** throw them in the waste bin.
- **IMPORTANT:** Never flush your lenses down the toilet or sink!

## EXTERNAL PACKAGING<sup>1,2</sup>

- Cardboard packaging can be recycled by municipal household waste management.

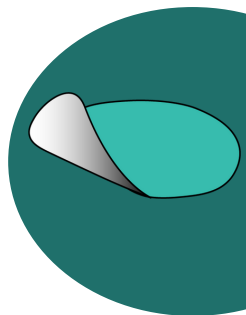


## BLISTER TRAYS<sup>1,2</sup>

- Ensure they are dry before dropping off.
- **Best option:** Drop off collected blister trays at a specialist recycling bin.
- **If not accessible:** throw them in the waste bin.

## FOIL LIDS<sup>1,2</sup>

- **Best option:** Drop off collected foil lids at a specialist recycling bin.
- **If not accessible:** throw them in the waste bin.
